DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE – Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) –

As mandated by Section 6(h) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, the EPA has implemented measures to mitigate exposure to certain persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals. Over time, these chemicals accumulate in the environment and can pose risks to various exposed groups, including the general public, consumers, commercial users, and vulnerable subpopulations such as workers, subsistence fishers, tribes, and children. On January 6, 2021, the EPA issued five final rules addressing these PBT substances.

Nexperia B.V. declares that none of the five PBT substances regulated under TSCA Section 6(h) are present in our semiconductor products, as detailed in the table below:
