Article 9(1) and (2) of Directive 94/62/EC continue to apply until 31 December 2029 with regard to the essential requirement in point 1, first indent, of Annex II to that Directive (Article 70(1), point (b) of PPWR). That requirement is the minimization of packaging volume and weight, at requirement 1 above. For packaging placed on the market on or after 12 August 2026, see Nexperia's PPWR Packaging Conformity Statement.
